

**CALLING ALL WHEELS IN PA, NJ, DE, MD, WV, NY:**



Sergeant Timothy Simpson was killed on November 17, 2008 when his patrol car was struck by a vehicle being operated by an intoxicated driver.

At approximately 10:30 pm, Sergeant Simpson was en route to a robbery call when his patrol car was involved in a collision with a vehicle at the intersection of Allegheny and Aramingo Avenues. He was taken to a local hospital where he died from his injuries.

It was determined that the operator of the vehicle that struck Sergeant Simpson's patrol car was intoxicated and he was taken into custody.

Sergeant Simpson had served with the Philadelphia Police Department for 20 years and is survived by his wife and three children. He was assigned to the 24th District.

**On Monday, November 24, Sgt Timothy Simpson will be buried in Bensalem, PA.**

The Philadelphia Police Commissioner has asked for bikers to line both sides of Hulmeville Road for the entire 2 mile stretch leading to the cemetery—riders standing next to their bikes, holding an American flag. This will require more than one thousand bikes.

Use every mailing list. Call in sick. Be at the Bensalem High School parking lot at NOON on Monday, November 24. WE NEED YOU, so drive/cage it if necessary—but bring your flag! Please, spread the word and show your support to our first responders.

**Warriors' Watch Riders (warriorwatch.org) will be assisting the Bensalem Police in logistics, staging and traffic control.**

Warriors' Watch Riders does not care what club you ride with. All are welcome. If you do not have a motorcycle, cage it. The important thing is to bring a 3' x 5' flag to stand a flagline as the funeral procession rolls by.

You do not need to personally introduce yourself...but be ready to be called to a ride briefing approximately 10 minutes before the KSU time.
